My dear Rabbi Schneersohn,

We acknowledge receipt of your letter dated March 22, 1948, in which you call to our attention a communication received by you from the organization of Jewish Refugees in Italy concerning their Passover needs.

You will be pleased to know that we have been in communication with our office in Italy and that the needs as outlined in your letter have been met. All Jewish DPs whether in camps or not, whether receiving regular JDC relief or not, will receive matzoth and matzoh meal for Passover. We have also allocated an amount for shmura for those elements who insist on having that kind of matzoth for the Passover Holidays. We pass this on for your information so that you may be informed of the actual situation.
