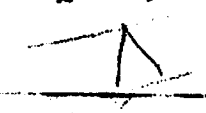

Dear Mr. Levin Epstein,

I think we may have to ask the Zionist Commission on the occasion of Passover to help us to get Motzas. I have written to Lieut. Colonel J.H. Patterson D.S.O. and to Lieut. Colonel E.L. Margolin D.S.O. suggesting that we ask Headquarters to give us a money allowance in lieu of the bread. The difficulty will be to secure the things, which I hope the Commission will be able to get for us, as I have nobody that I can send to Jerusalem who will be able to do this. We are not as far as my Battalion is concerned we are about 1250 strong. We are not asking of course for help in buying the Motzas. We have just come up to Haifa and the Battalion is doing work at various places along the line so we shall not be able to celebrate the Passover in mass. If you or any of the Committee come to Haifa we shall hope to see you. If you will let me know I will send cart to meet you at the station.
