- 111.1 (1928) Stamp depicts a portrait of Rabbi Kook in an oval frame. Below and on either side of the frame are depicted some buildings. The inscription across the top of the stamp reads 'COLLEGE AND FREE SCHOOL ETZ HAIM' and on the left and right side of the oval frame "BICUR HOLIM" and "HOSPITALS". Outside of the top frame is the caption "HELP THE UNITED CHARITY". Centered below the frame is the value "25c" and below that "INSTITUTIONS OF JERUSALEM. Printed in Turquoise ink on cream paper. (39mm x 25mm Perf. 14).....\$5.00
- 111.1x Sheet of 20 stamps (4 x 5) SE4S.....\$110.00
- 111.2 (1929) Similar to 111.1 except the stamp is much smaller and Hebrew text is added below the buildings. The value is "10c". The organization address is printed across the bottom, outside the frame. Printed in Dark Blue ink. (24mm x 16mm Perf. 12).....\$5.00
- 111.2x Sheet of 100 stamps (10 x 10) SE4S.....\$525.00
- 111.3 (1929) Stamp shows the value "25c" in all four corners. The organization name is at the top and the address is at the bottom of the stamp. The word "MATZOH" is written in Hebrew on the right side. Written in Hebrew (Yiddish) in the center of the stamp is "FOR THE 1500 YOUNG CHILDREN, FOR THE 260 TALMUD STUDENTS, FOR THE 54 TEACHERS AND THEIR FAMILIES, FOR HUNDREDS OF SICK PEOPLE IN HOSPITALS". Printed in black ink. (33mm x 43mm Perf. 12).....\$15.00
- 111.3x Booklet pane of 4 stamps (2 x 2) SE4S.....\$70.00

- 111.4 (1930) Same as 111.2 except the perforations are !@ 1/2.....\$5.00

- 111.4a (xxxx) Same as 111.4 except printed in Grey ink with yellow gum.....\$5.00

- 111.5 (1931) Same as 111.3 except printed in Blue ink.....\$15.00

- 111.6 (1932) Same as 111.2 except printed on white paper with no gum and Perforated 12.....\$5.00
- 111.6x Booklet pane of 10 stamps (2 x 5) SE4S PM@T.....\$55.00
- 111.7 (1933) Same as 111.3 except Perforated 14 1/2.....\$15.00
- 111.8 (1934) Stamp depicts a nurse with a patient in bed in the center of the stamp. In all four corners is the value "5". In the lower left corner is a man studying with the caption above him "GRAND COLLEGE ETZ HAIM" and in the lower right corner two students with the caption above them "FREE SCHOOL ETZ HAIM". Caption across the top reads "UNITED CHARITY INST. OF JERUSALEM" below that "BIRCUR CHOLIM HOSPITALS". At the bottom, Hebrew script with the organization name and address. Printed in Violet ink. (26mm x 20mm. Perf. 12).....\$1.50

- 111.10 (1935) Stamp depicts a stylized Star of David reversed out of the Blue background. The value "5c" is printed in all four corners. In the upper left and right corner, the word "HELP" is written in both Hebrew and English and in the lower left and right corner, the word "FUND" in Hebrew and English. Printed over the Star of David the word "MAZOTH". At the bottom, the organization address. (37mm x 26mm Perf. 12).....\$5.00
